The Northern Westchester Chinese School (NWCS) is a lively place where children and adults of all ages can develop and enrich their understanding of Chinese culture and language. We offer an academic program from Pre-K to Grade Twelve that emphasizes the richness of traditional and simplified Chinese. Our students learn both the Chinese phonetic Bopomofo and Hanyu Pinyin.

Founded in 1969, NWCS is one of the oldest Chinese schools in Westchester County. Our academic programs also include a variety of Chinese cultural electives- Chinese painting and calligraphy, Chinese Knotting and Chess, Chinese table harp, Chinese dance, origami, kung fu, and Tai Chi.

NWCS is a non-profit organization. Our teachers are committed and dedicated to educate and broaden our students' understanding of the Chinese language and culture. Our school is located in Briarcliff Manor, at the Briarcliff Manor Middle School. We conduct our

classes on Saturday mornings throughout the regular school year.

WHY ATTEND NORTHERN WESTCHESTER CHINESE SCHOOL

- We have a well-structured and all-inclusive academic curriculum which ranges from Pre-K to Grade 12. We differentiate our teaching process into A-Track (Mandarin speaking families) and B- Track (Non-Mandarin speaking families) to meet the diverse learning needs of our students. Both tracks use similar textbooks and are required to achieve the same level of academic proficiency.
